Subject: Concerning American Soldiers of the Japanese race.

Reference is made to your informal action sheet of 19 June, file: AG 032.2 Holifield, Chet (17 June 43)0B-C.

The Administrative Assistant, Office of the Secretary of War, has changed the action slip on this paper from "Necessary action and preparation of reply for signature of Administrative Assistant" to "Direct reply". Under this change this office will make direct reply to Mr. Holifield.

In order that necessary information may be obtained to accomplish the action it is requested that this office be given the information on the following points:

- a. The approximate number of Japanese American soldiers now serving in the Army.
  - b. The number of Japanese American soldiers recruited
    - (1) In the continental United States
    - (2) Hawaiian and other insular possesstions.
- c. The number of Japanese American soldiers who have been released from the armed services, with a statement as to the reason for their release.

This office has conducted an informal conference with Mr. Holifield on this subject and other matters pertaining to the request in Mr. Holifield's letter. This information, betagee of a confidential nature, will be handled in a personal interview.

Includes approximately 380 male citizens from Hawaii; a tally of 105 Hawaiians made in Washington indicated 33 yes answers (31.47%); if we estimate that the same percentage of the entire group answered yes, then approximately 250 of the non-affirmative and no reply responses are found in the small Hawaiian group of 380. Of this total, 1263 were tallied at the center and the results received in a letter; 147 were tallied in the Washington Office.
