1. By the authority delegated to the Quartermaster General by 2nd Indorsement, AG 421.7 Insignia (9-15-42) OB-I, The Adjutant General's Office, October 8, 1942, the following shoulder sleeve insignia for the 442nd Combat Team is approved:

On a blue disc, $2\frac{1}{4}$ " in diameter, a red and white bomb-burst behind a yellow gauntleted arm holding a sword white and red counterchanged all within a $1/8$ " white border.

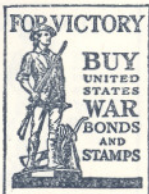

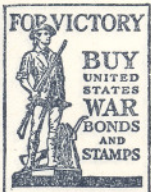
