



I am inclosing for your information a list of registrants examined at the Central Re-location Camps in Utah and the Manzanar Camp at Manzanar, California.

You will note that approximately 50% of the volunteers are meeting the General Service requirements. Examinations have been completed at the two Arizona Camps, but the reports have not been received in this office. Our doctors are scheduled to examine at Minidoka Camp on Tuesday, April 13. I am unable to carry out this procedure at Tule Lake for the reason that several thousand 304-A forms were executed there, but no one at the camp has a list of the ones who volunteered for service. Unless your offices can furnish me with such a list, I am unable to give an advance examination there, although the plan is certainly proving its worth in the experience of the two camps for which lists are inclosed.


